

SUPPLY LIST

For beginning silk dye painting

Jacquard Brand RED LABEL dyes 8oz bottles: (or the more expensive but preferable Sennelier Tinfix or Dupont silk dyes available online from www.dharmatrading.com. Please order primary colors in at least 500ml lbottles for the 3 primaries and the 100ml bottle for the black)

CYAN (blue)
MAGENTA
YELLOW
BLACK

Jacquard Brand Solvent Based Gutta Resist

Package of 3 applicator bottles with tips in various sizes

Small bottle (about 1oz or more) of Dupont Brand Dilutant

Small bottle of Synthrapol industrial soap (about 8 oz)

Salts, small containers with table salt, kosher salt, pickling salt

Silk scarves

Habotai (china silk) 100% silk scarves 11"x60" (8mm —this is the silk weight) or close enough to this measurement (12 scarves)

Brushes suitable for watercolors, needs to hold water

PVC pipe frame

3/4" diameter PVC *two* 10 feet long pipes
from Home Depot or Lowes cut to :

two pieces at 66 inches long
two pieces 20 inches long
corresponding 3/4" PVC pipe corners (elbows) to complete the frame (4 pieces)

Plastic buckets (four), anything we can turn upside down to use as supports for the PVC frame (Dollar store)

Chinese suspension hooks box of 24

Bag of rubber bands any size

Paper towels, rubber gloves, white ice cube tray, apron
