Beginning Watercolor / Kathy Rennell Forbes

Watercolor Paper (Suggest Arches):

2 full sheets of 140 lb. cold press watercolor paper (will cut at first class) OR
1 pad of 9x12 140 cold press watercolor paper

Watercolor Brushes

1 round brush, size 8 or 10 (suggest Loew-Cornell 7020 Ultra Round)
1 one inch flat brush
1 rigor brush, size 2 (optional)
1 scrubber brush (suggest Fabric Brush Round Scrubber #743, in size 1, 3 or 5)

Paints (small tube of best quality you can afford, I prefer Winsor & Newton)

Cadmium yellow medium	Lemon yellow or cadmium yellow light
Cadmium red light	Permanent carmine or alizarin crimson
Cerulean Blue	Fr. Ultramarine Blue or Cobalt blue
Viridian	Burnt sienna
Ivory black	

Palette to store paints and mix paints (get one with deep wells, a lid, and large mixing area)

Miscellaneous:

Small spray bottle for water
1 board 12x16 or larger (foam core board, heavy cardboard wrapped in contact paper, masonite board or plexiglass)
Roll of masking tape (1 inch)
Baby toothbrush or old toothbrush (wash in the dishwasher first)
Roll of paper towel
Pencil (#2) and kneaded eraser
Sponge (rectangular kitchen)
Plastic water container (cut up an old milk jug will demonstrate at first class)
2-4 clips to clamp paper to board
Bag to transport all of your supplies
