

# Chastain Arts Center - Supply List

## The Art of Collage / Suzy Ferriss

### Required:

- **14" x 17" pad drawing paper** (suitable for both dry and wet media)
- **Bristol Board Pad**, medium finish recommended, 18" x 24"
- **Assorted drawing pencils** (4B, 2B, HB, 2H are recommended)
- **Assorted erasers** (kneaded, art gum, and Pink Pearl are recommended)
- **Pencil sharpener**
- At least **one dry colored medium** such as pastels, colored pencil, oil pastels, or colored markers
- **Acrylic Paints:** white, black, plus an assortment of colors (red, blue, yellow, green, orange, and violet recommended)
- Brushes suitable for acrylics, both rounds and flats, assorted sizes from small detail to 1"
- **Assorted alternative brushes** (house painting brushes, toothbrushes, etc.)
- Various sized **plastic containers** for water and paint
- Disposable **palette** pad, plastic palette, or paper plates for mixing paints
- **Cotton rag or paper towels**
- Several sheets of **thin cardboard** (file folders work well)
- **Ruler** (18" cork backed recommended)
- **Scissors**
- **Tape** such as Scotch Magic tape, painter's tape, and/or masking tape (tape that will not tear your paper as you peel it off is ideal)
- **Glue** (glue stick and white all-purpose glue such as Elmer's)
- **Magazine(s)** with interesting imagery
- **White scratch paper** such as computer paper
- **Additional items for collage**, such as photographs, postcards, maps, sheet music, light weight textures, fabrics, ribbons, advertisements, stationary, decorative papers, paper scraps, old drawing or painting projects, etc. etc. Basically anything that can be cut up and adhered with glue.

### Optional but useful:

- **Xacto knife with blades**
- **One sheet nicer paper**, approximately 18" x 24" or larger (make sure it is heavy enough to support collage materials)
- **1 sheet or roll of graphite paper**
- **Charcoal (1 stick of vine or compressed, or 1 charcoal pencil)**
- **Conte crayon (white, brown, black recommended)**
- **Black India ink with and brush suitable for ink or pen staff** and assorted pen points (India Ink for drawing, not mechanical pens. Can be purchased in kit. Make sure ink is for drawing, not lettering)
- **Black fine point sharpie marker**
- **Old shirt or smock** (acrylics are permanent!)
