Ebola: Political Will and Public Health: This exhibit is an investigation of the historic 2014-16 Ebola Fever Virus epidemic in West Africa, the United States, and around the world. As the crisis unfolded in Guinea, Liberia, and Sierra Leone in 2014, it evolved into both a health and humanitarian crisis. Once it became clear that Ebola could potentially spread exponentially, threatening global health security, there was a coordinated, massive response. Story of CDC Exhibit: The exhibit traces the origins and early history of the CDC through its expansion into an agency of public health programs emphasizing prevention. The story is told using documents, photographs and objects from the CDC collection.
