#### Special Instructions:

##### Bus Information

The bus should park in the bus parking located on the left of the museum (when facing it) and the group can follow the sidewalk to the museum entrance or they can drop them off in front of the museum before parking.

##### Directions

From the East or West, take Interstate 20 to the Moreland Avenue North exit, following Moreland Avenue north approximately two miles to Freedom Parkway. Turn left on Freedom Parkway, and follow the signs to the Carter Center.

From the North or South, take Interstate 75/85 to exit 248C, Freedom Parkway. Follow the signs to the Carter Center.

##### Visitation Norms

We ask that people do not bring any food or drink (including water bottles) into the museum, including no chewing gum. We ask that everyone be respectful of our artifacts and space, therefore there is no flash photography allowed, no running, and no touching of the objects. Most importantly we want everyone to have a wonderful time!

### Chaperones

There is no set number of how many students need to be in each smaller group, but you may want to do 15 -20 students (with the correct number of chaperones) for each smaller group.

Upon arrival, the groups should break up into smaller groups and before going in to explore the museum, the point of contact for the group should walk over to the Museum Gift Shop associates and check in. Then, they will be welcome to go through our museum! I would suggest starting at different points throughout the museum so as to avoid congestion in any one area.
