## POP-UP RAKU WORKSHOP / Bob Petersen

In this one-day Raku workshop we will discuss the general history, philosophy and methods in firing ceramics in a raku kiln. Glazing techniques will be demonstrated and put into practice. Whether this is your first time Raku firing or you have experience, all levels are welcome to participate.

### What to Bring:

- 4 to 6 bisque fired pots. Fired at cone 04/06, 6 to 8 inches tall or smaller and no more than 6" in diameter. Please have one bisque pot glazed before the workshop
- Flat pieces like plates and wide bowls can be problematic and for purposes of this workshop are discouraged
- Notebook and pencil/pen
- Food/snack
- Proper attire long sleeves, long pants (no synthetics), no open toed shoes, ties for hair.

\*Be aware that raku firing does not produce work suitable for food service and vessels may be too porous to hold liquid.

Note: Do to time constraints for the workshop we cannot guarantee all pieces will be fired.

Two weeks later, on the second Saturday we will meet again and plant succulents in the wonderful pots YOU created! 3 succulent plants, potting mix, clay, and tools will be provided. No experience is needed!

**POP-UP FOLD-FORMING COPPER BANGLE WORKSHOP/** Robert McGinnis

Fold-forming is a unique metalsmithing technique within a category of its own. In this two-day copper bangle class. We will execute creative freedom as well as craftsmanship. Primarily focusing on the art of fold-forming sheet copper, this class is great for the inquisitive beginner to the intermediate smith or jeweler. A \$10 materials fee has been added for the copper.
