

Chastain Arts Center Supply List

Learn to Paint / Kendall Portis

Students may choose any subject matter to paint. They can bring their own photo reference or if they wish can paint from a still life that will be provided for each class.

Brushes

- 1 size #4 and 1 size #8 Flat or Filbert
- 1 Medium size Palette Knife

Paints / Materials

- Students can choose from Oil, Acrylic, or Gouache (Watercolor).
- If using Oil paint please bring only Gamsol or Turpenoid to use as a solvent in class.
- Roll of paper towels
- Palette to mix color
- Container for cleaning brushes
- Suggested sizes: Anything around 11x14, nothing larger than 16x20.
 - For Oil paint you will need a gessoed canvas or board.
 - Gouache can be used on watercolor paper.
 - Acrylic is applied on canvas, board or paper.

Colors

- Mars or Ivory Black
- Titanium White (large tube)
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Ultramarine Blue (large tube)

Not mandatory but highly recommended is a small sketch book preferably with toned paper. A tool to make black and white marks. Pencil/marker for black and Prismacolor or similar brand pencil/stick for white.

Students are welcome to bring and use any brushes or paint colors they already have. Specific materials needed will be fully discussed during the first class about the goals and objectives of each individual student.
