NEW! INTRODUCTION TO DRAWING: MEDIA & TECHNIQUES/ Suzy Ferriss

A beginning and intermediate class that presents to students the absolute basics of drawing. Students will learn to work with a variety of media including pencil, charcoal, conte, and ink, while becoming familiar with techniques and styles associated with each. This is the perfect class for those new to art, as well as for those who want to further develop their skills.

HEAD & HANDS WORKSHOP/ Ben Smith

This class will approach the tasks of drawing by analyzing the head and hands from a structural point of view with geometric analysis and methodology for tonal and linear rendering. Please bring a drawing board, an 18"x24" newsprint pad, #2B pencil, soft vine charcoal, and pink Pearl eraser to the first class. Additional materials will be discussed the first day of class. Approximately a \$20-\$40 model fee will be collected in the first class.

Painting techniques explored during class include staining, impasto, tape, drip, mixed media, and various other methods of paint application. This class is suitable for all levels and is perfect for those new to art, as well as for those who want to further develop their skills.

NEW! FIGURE SCULPTURE W/ LIVE MODEL / Iris Eve Schaer

Over the course of these four days, we will sculpt the figure with the help of a model. We will focus on quick gestural maquettes along with longer times poses. A general knowledge of human anatomy and figure sculpting is preferred. There will be demonstrations and hands-on instruction as needed. Please note that there will be some movement required throughout the classroom. A model fee of approximately \$50 will be collected from each student at the first class.

This Raku workshop we will discuss the general history, philosophy and methods in firing ceramics in a raku kiln. Glazing techniques will be demonstrated and put into practice. Whether this is your first time Raku firing or you have experience, all levels are welcome to participate.

What to Bring:

- 4 to 6 bisque fired pots. Fired at cone 04/06, 6 to 8 inches tall or smaller and no more than 6" in diameter. Please have one bisque pot glazed before the workshop
 - You can purchase pots to Raku for \$20
- Flat pieces like plates and wide bowls can be problematic and for purposes of this workshop are discouraged
- Notebook and pencil/pen
- Food/snack
- Proper attire long sleeves, long pants (no synthetics – ONLY COTTON), no open toed shoes, and hair tied up.

*Be aware that raku firing does not produce work suitable for food service and vessels may be too porous to hold liquid.

Note: Do to time constraints for the workshop we cannot guarantee all pieces will be fired.

Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis! Register early to avoid disappointment.

You may pay for classes with any major credit card or by check. We cannot accept cash. Registration cannot be processed prior to the first day of registration. After you purchase a class in person or over the phone, a receipt is emailed to the email on file, but the office does not send out confirmations. If you registered in person or by phone, and are not certain about a class, please call the center prior to the first day of class to verify the day and time of the class, and your enrollment.

REGISTRATION POLICY:

You can register one non-family member per registration. Students may register multiple people, but only if they are considered family and in the 'Family' section of their ActiveNet profile.

PLEASE NOTE:

All classes require enough enrollment to convene. Chastain Arts Center reserves the right to cancel, reschedule or combine classes, to change instructors, fees and/or classroom assignments when necessary.

Any cancellation of or change made to a scheduled class will be made a minimum of two days prior to the first-class meeting. *Students will be notified using the e-mail or phone number provided at the time of registration.* Full refunds will be issued for cancelled classes.

REFUND POLICY:

Students must notify the Center personally in order to withdraw from a class. A written request sent to ChastainArts@AtlantaGA.gov is required for all withdrawals and refund requests. Please include your name, the name of the class, and—if requesting a refund—your reason for withdrawal.

In order to receive a refund, students must submit their request at least 3 business days before the first class. If a withdrawal is made during the class, a class credit may be issued to your account for use on a future class. This credit will be valid for one fiscal year. No refunds or transfers are guaranteed after this time.

The Center is not responsible for classes missed due to student absence. Please discuss any unavoidable absence with your instructor.

In some program areas, students not enrolled in a class may register for open studio time. Open studio begins the second week of the session. The schedule will be posted by the first scheduled day of open studio. Open studio ends on the last day of the session.
